


Report on the 11th EPODES Basic Online Theoretical Course, Brno, Czech Republic, January 24-28, 2022.

First of all, I am grateful that I could attend this international teaching course on epilepsy surgery that is organized by prof. Ivan Rektor since 2008 in Brno with a regular participation of epilepsy specialists.
